## NOTES FROM THE VILLAGE OFFICE

**Please be advised that the 10% penalty will be reinstated for utility bills not paid by the due date starting September 2020.**

*Village Council thanks all our residents and ratepayers who attended the public meeting on Tuesday, August 25<sup>th</sup>. We appreciated your comments and feedback regarding municipal taxes and finances.*

The minimum tax was first announced in our May community newsletter. However, we realize there were some communications issues associated with it since then. It is our goal to provide accessible information. Council recognizes you want more information on our operations and plans, and will be reviewing how to get it to you.

We have a website, Facebook page, and monthly newsletter. And our monthly utility bills can be used to convey information. We will discuss how the Village uses these tools.

There was a really good turnout for the meeting (38 people). We are grateful to those who took the time to attend. **Council will be holding another public meeting in February of 2021.**

**Residential Property taxes are due by September 15th, 2020.**

If taxes are not paid by September 15th, 2020 a 12% penalty will be applied to the current taxes  
**Non Residential Property Taxes are due by October 15th, 2020**
