Village Council has authorized Atco Power to proceed with the conversion of our streetlights to

LED. Atco expects the conversion to take place in the summer or fall of 2021, dependent on when the regulatory approval is received the from Alberta Utilities Commission.

Village Council is in the process of finalizing our strategic plan. We will share the results of those meetings once the plan is finalized.

We continue to charge \$10.00 per month in situations where the water meters are not recording consumption. Our public works staff are continuing to deal with this issue.

Residents are advised to renew their dog tags and cat tags for the 2021 calendar year. Having a current



tag keeps your animal protected if it strays from home. It helps other people who find your pet determine who the owner is. Both cat and dog tags must be renewed annually. Rates are \$20.00 for neutered/spayed dogs and cats; and \$25.00 for non-neutered/spayed dogs and cats. Make sure that the tag is on your pet securely.
