The Chief Administrative Officer (CAO) will oversee a small staff in the daily operations.

The successful candidate will provide leadership that will inspire, develop, and maintain a safe and empowering work environment for the staff, while fostering positive relationships with its regional partners and the public. Some onsite training can be provided by the incumbent CAO, who is retiring.

The ideal candidate will possess:

- Experience as a CAO or Senior Manager in a municipal government setting, or in a Senior Management position in a non-governmental organization coupled with post-secondary education in a related discipline, or in the process of completing certification in local government management.
