The Municipal Elections take place in Alberta on October 18, 2021. This includes the five Council positions overseeing the Village of Berwyn.

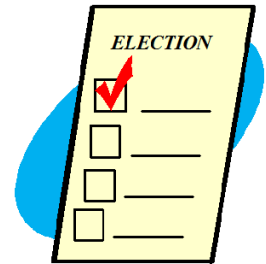
Membership on Village Council is a rewarding opportunity to provide leadership in the community, and be involved in regional boards and agencies dealing with activities like economic development; seniors housing; and libraries. You receive hands-on experience with the wide gamut of services that local governments provide to their citizens.

Council meetings are held twice a month and other

board meetings are held monthly or quarterly.

Your present Council consists of: Mayor Cindy Hockley; Councilors Ken Montie; Kim Steeves; Brianne Nettelfield; and John Bak.



Berwyn's water and sewer rehabilitation project is scheduled to start on May 25th 2021. Excavations commence south of 49th Avenue and east of 50th Street. Water service lines; curb stops; and saddles will be replaced and sewer services may be replaced in the back alleys.

Similar work will be done West of 50th Street, between 50th and 51st Street south of 50th Avenue. Work will also be done East of 50th Street, between 50th Avenue and 53rd Avenue. More information will be provided on the Village's website closer to the date of commencement. During these repairs there will be temporary disruptions to water and sewer services, usually about one hour in duration. The project is scheduled to be completed by July 21st.

Village Council has prepared a draft strategic plan.

We will be posting it on the web page in the near future, and soliciting public opinion then.

We continue to charge \$10.00 per month in situations where the water meters are not recording consumption. Our public works staff are continuing to deal with this issue.

We are still looking at our sidewalks, and deciding what needs to be replaced. It would be appreciated, in areas where the lawn is starting to creep over the sidewalk, if residents could trim the lawns back. Please also trim back trees and shrubs overhanging the sidewalks.
