Residents of the Village of Berwyn:

Please be advised that the recent water bill may be higher this month due to the following: Meters were read early in December 2018 and they were also read later this month in January 2019. As you will also recall, a small increase to the water rates was also implemented as of January 1, 2019. If you have any questions please call the Village office at 780 338-3922

Authorization must be granted to operate any off-highway vehicle within town limits. A written request must be sent to the Chief Administrative Officer to receive approval.

- If driving within town limits the off-highway must be equipped with one or more headlamps aimed on a straight level surface so the light intensity portion of the beam will not shine in the eyes of an approaching driver;
- Valid insurance documents must be on the vehicle at all times;
- An approved safety helmet must be worn at all times;
- Section 2 of The Village of Berwyn Noise Control Bylaw must be strictly followed;
- An Off-Highway Vehicle permit (\$25.00) must be purchased **annually** and kept on the vehicle at all times;
- While operating the off-highway vehicle, a visible neon orange safety flag must be attached (flags are available at the Village Office for \$15.00); and
- Permits are approved for the vehicle described in the request and is not transferrable to additional operators or off highway vehicles.
