Notes from the Village Office

It is mandatory to wear a mask when you're at the Village Office. We appreciate your cooperation.

The Village of Berwyn has passed its 2021 budget. Tax rates will remain unchanged from last year. Your amount of taxes paid may vary dependent on whether your assessment went up or down. More information on the budget will be included in the tax notices.



The water and sewer rehabilitation project has commenced! For those who live in the affected areas, we appreciate your patience during the temporary disruptions of water and sewer services.

Tax notices will go out in June, we have not set the date of mailing yet. There is a 12.00% penalty levied on unpaid property taxes that is added 45 days after mailing.

We have some good news on the recycling front. After discussions with the recycling contractor, we can relax the sorting restrictions. Any cardboard can now be put in any paper or cardboard bin. Even plastic can be put in any bin. The only material that has to be kept separate is glass.

We continue to charge \$10.00 per month in situations where the water meters are not recording consumption. Our public works staff are continuing to deal with this issue.
