

### NOTES FROM THE VILLAGE OFFICE

Thanks to all who participated in our recycling/garbage collection survey.

After some discussion at the January 28, 2021 meeting, Village Council voted to continue to use our current existing recycling and garbage collection services, in response to the survey results.

The survey results were: 59 respondents wished to continue to use existing services; 45 respondents wished to change both Recycling and Garbage Services; 2 respondents favored only changing recycling services;

and two respondents wished to change the garbage collection service.

We did have some residents asking about the rules for garbage collection.

The rules are posted at our regional landfill's website – <u>www.longlakeregionalwaste.com</u>. – link to Residential Pickup Guidelines, Manning and Berwyn.

The Village of Berwyn is pleased to offer e-transfer to pay water and sewer bills, or municipal taxes. Please remember to state your name and account in the notes section of the e-transfer website. No password is required, as we have auto deposit set up. Make sure to send your transfer to the current address –

Volunteer help is requested for preparing a temporary ice rink. Because of the ongoing provincial CO-VID restrictions, which do not show any signs of being lifted, the arena has been closed to public use. However, we are attempting to get an outdoor rink made at the parking lot east of the arena. Volunteers would assist with flooding the ice; and

shoveling it after snowfalls.
People who would be able
to help out in the evenings
would be welcome,
although assistance can be
used at any time.



Residents are advised to renew their dog tags and cat tags for the 2021 calendar year. Having a current



tag keeps your animal protected if it strays from home. It helps other people who find your pet determine who the owner is. Both cat and dog tags must be renewed annually. Rates are \$20.00 for neutered/spayed dogs and cats; and \$25.00 for non-neutered/spayed dogs and cats. Make sure that the tag is on your pet securely.
