"Acceptable Fireplace"

means an outdoor receptacle for cooking purposes only that meets the following specifications

- ◇ (i) a minimum of 3 meter clearance measured from the nearest fireplace edge shall be maintained from buildings, property lines or any combustible material
- ◇ (ii) The fire pit height shall not exceed 0.6 meters when measure from the surrounding grade to the top of the fire pit opening
- ◇ (iii) The outside width, length, or diameter of the fire pit opening shall not exceed 1 meter when measured between the widest outside edges
- ◇ (iv) The fire pit installation shall have enclosed sides made from bricks, concrete blocks, heavy gauge metal, or other non-combustible materials acceptable to the fire chief
- ◇ (v) A regulation screen shall be used to cover the fire put opening in a manner sufficient to contain and reduce the hazards of airborne sparks.
