Bylaw No. 667

A Bylaw of the Village of Berwyn, in the Province of Alberta, for the purpose of adopting the Municipal District of Peace No. 135 and the Village of Berwyn Intermunicipal Collaboration Framework (ICF), pursuant to the current Municipal Government Act mandate.

WHEREAS Division 1, Section 708.28 (1) of the Municipal Government Act as of February 1, 2019, mandates that municipalities that have common boundaries must create an Intermunicipal Collaboration Framework (ICF) with each other that identifies the services provided by each municipality, which services are best provided on an intermunicipal basis, and how services to be provided on an intermunicipal basis will be delivered and funded.

WHEREAS the Municipal District of Peace No. 135 and the Village of Berwyn share a common border;

WHEREAS the Municipal District of Peace No. 135 and the Village of Berwyn share common interests and are desirous of working together to provide services to their residents;

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Council of the Village of Berwyn, in the Province of Alberta, adopts the Municipal District of Peace No. 135 and the Village of Berwyn Intermunicipal Collaboration Framework Agreement, being the document attached hereto and forming part of this Bylaw.

This Bylaw comes into force and effect on the date of passing of Third Reading.
