Bylaw No. 672

Utility Rate for Non-Functioning Water Meters

A Bylaw of the Village of Berwyn in the Province of Alberta to amend Bylaw #669 for non-functioning water meters.

WHEREAS, the Municipal Government Act permits a municipality to pass a bylaw fixing rates and charges for public utilities and services.

AND WHEREAS, the malfunctioning of water meters is causing a substantial revenue loss for the municipality.

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of the Village of Berwyn, duly assembled, hereby enacts as follows:

THAT, Bylaw #669 be amended by the inclusion of the following clauses.

THAT, a charge of \$10.00 per month be added to every utility account with a non-functioning water meter.

AND THAT, this charge be lifted as soon as the water meter is repaired.

AND THAT, this Bylaw come into effect on July 1, 2020
