CHANGES IN THE UTILITY RATES 2020

This is to advise residents and businesses of a change in the base rates for water and sewer.

The base rate for water service is going up by \$2.00 per month on all accounts. In addition to that, sewer rates are also increasing by \$2.00 per month on all accounts. Garbage and recycling charges remain unchanged. Rates for metered water remain unchanged.

These changes will take effect on March 1, 2020, and will show up on the utility bills that are mailed out near the end of March. For more information, please contact the Village Office.

SEWER LINE NOTICE

Many property owners assume that they are only responsible for repair and replacement of their sewer service from their residence to the property line. This is not the case.

Section Four of our utility policy states that Village property owners are responsible for their sewer lines from the residence (or business) right to the sewer main. This includes, but not limited to, any sewer backups, clogged lines, leaks, and general maintenance and upkeep.
