NOTES FROM THE VILLAGE OFFICE

Here are a few ways you can make your payments to the village office

We have had ongoing problems with our water meters. A large number of them are not working properly, so many of our customers have not been billed for water consumption. As an interim measure, **Council has passed a bylaw putting in place a \$10.00 charge for every account with non-working meters.** This replaces the consumption charge of \$2.00 a cubic metre. This charge will first appear on the utility invoices mailed at the end of July.

Staff are working on getting this problem resolved.

Berwyn Village Council meetings have been set for the summer months.
Regular meetings will be held on **Thursday, July 23, 2020, and Thursday, August 27, 2020.**
