

**Bylaw No. 631
CIVIC ADDRESSING BYLAW
OF THE VILLAGE OF BERWYN
IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA**


A Bylaw of the Village of Berwyn, in the Province of Alberta, to provide and regulate the address numbering of all residential and business establishments in the Village.


WHEREAS it is considered expedient by the Council that buildings in the Villages should be numbered;

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of the Village of Berwyn, at a duly assembled meeting, enacts as follows:

1. That an orderly system of numbering buildings be compiled for the Village of Berwyn.
2. That the system of numbering shall relate to the numbers of the streets and avenues within the Village.
3. That the address number plates shall be of a size not less than three (3) inches in height and placed on the frontage of the property as to be seen clearly from the roadway.
4. That the placement and purchase of the street address numbers shall be the responsibility of the property owner.
5. That street address numbers shall be placed on newly constructed buildings on completion of the construction.
6. That every person that contravenes this Bylaw, is guilty of an offence, is liable to a fine of \$50.00 (fifty dollars) on summary conviction.
7. This Bylaw shall come into full force and take effect upon third (3rd) reading thereof.
8. Bylaw No. 468 is hereby repealed.




