68 people from Berwyn voted in the October 18th Senate Election and Referendum questions. In order to comply with the Local Authorities Election Act, we were required to ask for Photo Identification.

Most people used their drivers' license for that. But because the drivers' license shows only a post office box number for your address, we needed another piece

of identification to validate your civic address. Many people found that requirement quite annoying. We are researching some options so that, (hopefully) at the next election we will need only one piece of identification. The requirement for some picture ID will probably always there in future municipal elections.

We thank Rick Dostaler for all the sidewalk work he did for us this fall. This helped us utilize a Municipal Stimulus Grant to get some capital work done.

Rick's crew also repaired a lot of the trip hazards that we had on our sidewalks.
