Community **Volunteer Income Tax Program**

For the current year tax season, The Town of Grimshaw Community Services
Department will be working with <u>one regional CVITP volunteer</u> to hold a free tax
service to eligible residents of Berwyn, MD of Peace and Grimshaw.
The Town of Grimshaw Community Services Department will be a <u>drop-off</u>

In order to be eligible for the Community Volunteer Income Tax Program, individuals must have a modest income This may include include:

- adults 65 years and olderhousing-insecure individuals
- · Indigenous Peoples
- modest-income individuals
 newcomers
 persons with disabilities
- students

The guideline to determine what is considered a modest income means the total family income is less than \$52,500.00 dollars, based on the size of the family of five. (Family size includes an individual, or a couple, and their dependants.

The Community Volunteer Income Tax Program will operate from <u>February 20 to April 30, 2024</u> with our regional CVITP volunteer who is trained to complete current year income tax and benefit returns for eligible individuals.

BERWYN COUNCIL MEETING HIGHLIGHTS

January 11, 2024:

2024 Budget

Dates were set for Council's 2024 budget discussions. Council will meet on February 4, 2024 to discuss the operating budget and on February 11, 2024, for the capital budget.

Council Reviews FCSS 2023 Program Report

Council reviewed the Family and Community Support Services (FCSS) annual report provided by Tracy Halerewich, Director of Community Services. Council expressed appreciation for the wide-range of programming provided for residents in the Village of Berwyn and the entire region by the Town of Grimshaw Community Services Department.

Snow Removal

Council directed administration to discuss snow removal with the Village of Berwyn Public Works Department.

January 25, 2024:

Spring Municipal Leaders Caucus

Council approved that Deputy Mayor Nicole Johnson and Councillor Jane and Dan Weber attend the 2024 Spring Municipal Leaders Caucus taking place in Edmonton from March 14 - 15, 2024.





Municipal Affairs Correspondence

Council reviewed correspondence from the Minister of Municipal Affairs commending the Village of Berwyn for its progress since the 2018 viability review. The Minister also questioned and requested an update on tax collection rates, the infrastructure age in the Village, and electors' lack of interest in municipal office. Council engaged in discussions surrounding the aforementioned topics and directed administration to respond to Minister Ric McIver.

2024 Goals

Council engaged in discussions regarding goals for 2024 with a focus on partnerships/relationships with municipal neighbours, completing mainstreet infrastructure, and lagoon maintenance. The council requested that this be a discussion topic placed on all future council meeting agendas.

Financial Reports

Council reviewed various financial reports and expressed gratitude to Greta Vasadi, Village of Berwyn Finance Clerk for her diligence and work in enhancing the organization and reporting of the Village's financial records.
