- If you register for paperless utility billing by June 30th, a one time credit of \$10.00 shall be applied to your utility account in August of 2023.
- Seniors (65+) and persons with disabilities can make a request to waive the \$2.00 a month administration fee. Starting July their will be a monthly \$2.00 administration fee to those who don't go paperless.

Berwyn Bylaw Report for January to March was approved by Council.

Village of Berwyn renewed the Mutual Aid Agreement with the between the parties of: The Town of Grimshaw; Northern Sunrise County; County of Northern Lights; The Municipal District of Peace No. 135; The Town of Peace River; Municipal District of Smoky River No. 130; The Village of Berwyn. Any one of the parties to the Agreement, if and when in need of help to combat a fire or emergency incident, may request aid from one or more of the other parties, subject to conditions.

A local business donated five properties on 49th Street to the Village.

Peace River Arts Club gave Council a presentation.

Lac Cardinal Economic Development had three members give presentations.

A BYLAW OF THE VILLAGE OF BERWYN IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA TO ESTABLISH RATES FOR WATER, SEWER, GARBAGE AND RECYCLING SERVICES.

REGULAR RATES MONTHLY	WATER	SEWER	GARBAGE	RECYCLING
Residential	\$17.70	\$17.70	\$21.24	\$4.72
Residential Reduced (on a Guaranteed Income Supplement, Widow or Disability pension)	\$10.62	\$ 10.62	\$16.52	\$4.72
Commercial	\$22.42	\$22.42		\$4.72
Institutional (school, lodge, villa)	\$27.14	\$79.06	\$24.78 (school only)	\$4.72
Unoccupied	\$16.52	\$ 13.02	\$20.06	\$4.72
