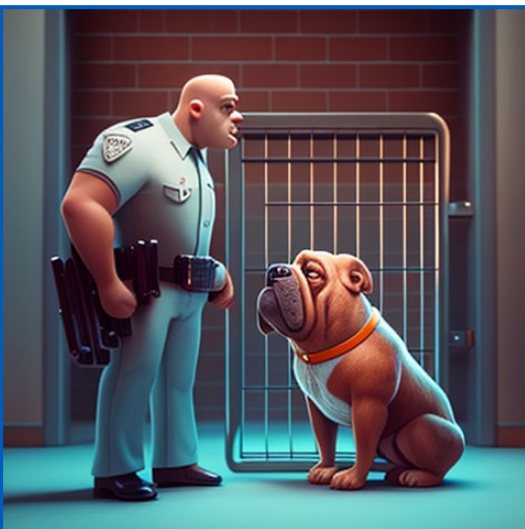

Village of Berwyn is looking to Hire a Animal Control Person

Capture of dogs, cats and abandoned animals by providing and using whatever humane methods of capture and equipment are required, pursuant to the Animal Control Bylaw.

Carrying out the enforcement of the Animal Control Bylaw on a complaint response basis and also appearing in court when required to give evidence.

Providing a vehicle for the purpose of patrolling and for capturing animals when required to do so.

Ensuring that all captured animals are humanly treated and placed in the pound at the earliest convenience after capture.

Submitting an animal capture information report and/or copy of each ticket issued for each animal impounded to the Village office.

Community Volunteer Income Tax Program

For the current year tax season, The Town of Grimshaw Community Services Department will be working with one regional CVITP volunteer to hold a free tax service to eligible residents of Berwyn, MD of Peace and Grimshaw.

The Town of Grimshaw Community Services Department will be a drop-off location.

In order to be eligible for the Community Volunteer Income Tax Program, individuals must have a modest income and a simple tax situation.

This may include include:

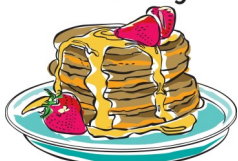
- adults 65 years and older
- housing-insecure individuals
- Indigenous Peoples
- modest-income individuals
- newcomers
- persons with disabilities
- students

The guideline to determine what is considered a modest income means the total family income is less than \$52,500.00 dollars, based on the size of the family of five. (Family size includes an individual, or a couple, and their dependants.

The Community Volunteer Income Tax Program will operate from February 20 to April 30, 2023 with our regional CVITP volunteer who is trained to complete current year income tax and benefit returns for eligible individuals.
