- If you register for paperless utility billing by June 30th, a one time credit of \$10.00 shall be applied to your utility account in August of 2023.
- Seniors (65+) and persons with disabilities can make a request to waive the \$2.00 a month administration fee.

March 9 & 23, 2023

March 9, 2023 Meeting - A date was chosen for the Public Meeting, it will be held on
April 6, 2023 from 7:00 to 9:00p.m. at the Ag Hall (old Legion Hall on Main Street)

Sgt. Dave Browne from the Peace River RCMP Detachment gave Council a report about Provincial
Policing, Community Priorities, and spoke about Crime Stats. Council suggested a larger police
presence in Berwyn. They will be attending the Public Meeting on April 6, 2023.

Bylaw 699 Utility Rates Bylaw was passed at the March 9th meeting and has been placed on the website.
