

Village of Berwyn
Bylaw No. 685

A Bylaw of the Village of Berwyn in the Province of Alberta to repeal Bylaws #661 and 670.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Municipal Government Act, being Chapter M—26 of the statutes of Alberta 2000 as amended, the power to pass a bylaw under this or any other enactment includes a power to amend or repeal a bylaw; and

WHEREAS, Council deems it appropriate to repeal certain obsolete and superseded bylaws of the Village of Berwyn.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council of the Village of Berwyn free assembled hereby enacts as follows:

1. Citation

1.1. This Bylaw may be cited as the “Village of Berwyn Repeal 661 and 670 Bylaw.”

2. Provisions

2.1. That Bylaw 661, The Community Standards Bylaw be hereby repealed.

2.2. That Bylaw 670 an Amendment to the Community Standards Bylaw hereby repealed.

3. Severability


3.1. If any term of this Bylaw is found to be invalid, illegal, or unenforceable by a court or tribunal having the jurisdiction to do so, that term is to be considered to have been severed from the rest of this bylaw, and the rest of the bylaw remains in force unaffected by that finding or by the severance of that term.

4. Enactment

4.1. This Bylaw shall take effect at the date of the final passing thereof.
